

Makasutu Culture Forest Special Day Out

📍 Makasutu Culture Forest, West Coast Region, The Gambia



Makasutu is one of those places locals mention with real affection, and a day spent here shows exactly why. Part forest reserve, part living cultural showcase, it packs an unusual amount of Gambian life, tradition and wildlife into a single outing. The morning opens with a walk through the forest itself, past indigenous trees and medicinal plants that your guide can name on sight, before a relaxed boat cruise through the mangrove creeks, keeping an eye out for monkeys and a good variety of birdlife along the banks. What follows is harder to find anywhere else on a standard tour: a traditional palm wine tapper climbing a towering palm using techniques passed down for generations, then descending with the freshly harvested wine to share, and a visit to a marabout, a traditional healer and palm reader, who explains the part these figures play in Gambian community life. Traditional drumming and dance follow lunch, bringing the day's cultural thread together with plenty of energy. A proper Gambian lunch and some free time to relax and photograph the surroundings round things off nicely. For anyone after a genuine slice of Gambian culture alongside real nature, Makasutu delivers both in equal measure.

Meet a traditional marabout and learn about local customs and traditional healing practices.

Enjoy a delicious traditional Gambian lunch.

Experience traditional drumming and cultural dance performances.

Relax, take photographs, and explore the surroundings at your own pace.
