

Tendaba Camp - 1 day Inland

📍 Tendaba Camp, Bao Bolong Wetland Reserve, The Gambia



For anyone who wants Tendaba's wildlife without committing to an overnight stay, this full-day version covers the essentials well. The Bao Bolong Wetland Reserve remains one of West Africa's genuinely important wildlife habitats, and a single well-planned day is enough to see why. After the drive inland through Gambian farmland and villages, the boat cruise through the mangrove creeks is the clear highlight, with a strong chance of spotting birds, monkeys, crocodiles, and other wildlife along the banks. Lunch at the camp follows, with time afterwards to simply sit with the surroundings before the return drive to the coast. It's a more compact way to experience Tendaba, built for travellers who want the reserve's wildlife and scenery in a single satisfying day rather than a full overnight trip.
